TERMS AND CONDITIONS

(Based on industry standards)

- I. Cargo Motions, LLP, broker authority is MC 641605, hereafter referred to as BROKER, agrees to have the above listed vehicle(s) shipped on or about the dates requested. BROKER agrees to designate a reliable carrier to fulfill the terms and conditions of this agreement accompanying "Broker-Shipper Agreement" and "Order Confirmation." BROKER or its agents do not guarantee a specific pickup or delivery date.
- II. This vehicle transport order is subject to all terms and conditions of the carrier's straight bill of lading, copies of which is available at the office of carrier and is incorporated herein.
- III. The carrier's responsibility begins when the shipper or his agent signs the bill of lading at pickup, and terminates when the shipper or his agent signs the bill of lading upon delivery. BROKER must be notified, should the shipper be unavailable for pickup or delivery, and his agent must be designated at that time.

- IV. BROKER hereby notifies shipper that his vehicle will be driven on and off the transporter, or to and from the transporter at the pickup and/or delivery location, should the carrier be unable to access either site. This does not relieve the consignee from making a reasonable effort to meet the truck at a suitable location. If vehicle is not made available to transporter once they have been dispatched and pickup date has been confirmed, shipper will be charged for "Equipment Ordered but Not Used" and a cancellation fee has specified in the "Order Confirmation."
- V. BROKER does not guarantee transport by any specific driver/carrier. Primary insurance for shipper's vehicle(s) is provided by the carrier assigned to the shipment. BROKER is restricted by law from providing Primary Insurance coverage on the shipment.
- VI. Should vehicle(s) become inoperable during transport, \$150.00 will be due at time of delivery in addition to any other monies owed. It is the shipper's responsibility to make sure vehicle(s) is in proper working order.
- VII. BROKER or its agents will not knowingly transport vehicles with personal or household items in the passenger or trunk compartments. Federal regulations prohibit BROKER or its agents from doing so. If such items are shipped unbeknown to BROKER or its agents, such items become the sole responsibility of the shipper. Should damage occur or fines are levied said fines or damage is the shipper's responsibility.
- VIII. BROKER or its agents will not be responsible for vandalism, acts of nature (fire, Flooding, hail, sand storm, tornadoes, earthquakes, etc.) or objects flying from the road or sky during transport. Shipper should maintain his own insurance in the event these unfortunate events take place.
- IX. Shipper is responsible for preparing the vehicle(s) for transport, all loose parts fragile or protruding accessories, low hanging spoilers, fog lights, antennas, etc. must be removed and/or properly secured. Any part that falls off during transport is shipper's responsibility, including damages done by said part to any and all vehicles involved.
- X. If damage should occur, all monies owed for transport services must be paid to initiate a claim. Damage must be noted in the proper place on the bill of lading, and signed by driver and shipper, regardless of weather, or time of day. Signing the bill of lading without any notation of damage verifies that shipper or his agent has received said vehicle(s) in good condition, and that BROKER and its agents are relieved of any further responsibility. Shipper or his agent MUST inspect vehicle thoroughly.
- XI. BROKER must be notified of any damage within 24 hours. Shipper must submit a written documentation of any and all damage that occurred, photo evidence, and at least two (2) estimates for repair of the damages within ten (10) days of receipt of the damaged vehicle to the designated carrier for any resolution to be initiated. BROKER agrees to support shipper in his effort should such a problem occur, but in no way will BROKER accept responsibility for any negligence of the assigned carrier. If the vehicle(S) is valued at a higher vale than the current market rate, it is suggested that shipper purchase additional insurance rider specifically for transport.
- XII. Any claim or controversy arising from or relating to this agreement, or the performance or breech thereof, shall be subject to the jurisdictions of the State of New Jersey. Shipper specifically waives any right to judicature of this matter at any other location.

In signing this agreement, shipper fully agrees to terms and conditions contained herein. Shipper also certifies that any and all information provided above is correct and holds BROKER harmless in the event information is incorrect.
